2018 Fall Campout Rules, Regulations and Policies

- In order to request and be considered for a previous camping assignment, applications and payments must be received by October 1, 2018 and will be granted on a first-come, first-serve basis. NOTE there are no guarantees.
- After October 1, 2018, campers will be assigned spots based on access and availability.
- The **Oct 18-21 Weekend Permit** is valid Thursday, October 18, 2019 through Sunday, October 21, 2019. Camping units may be placed on assigned lots after 11am Thursday.
- The **Oct 25-28 Weekend Permit** is valid Thursday, October 25, 2019 through Sunday, October 28, 2019. Camping units may be placed on assigned lots after 11am Thursday.
- The **Full Fall Campout Permit** is valid Thursday, October 18, 2019 through Sunday, October 28, 2019. Camping units may be placed on assigned lots after 11am Thursday, October 18.
- Permit must be displayed on registered camper through the Fall Campout.
- One weekend is \$85. To stay on the fairgrounds for both weekends is \$170. No refunds will be granted after October 1, 2018.
- Camping locations to be determined by camping supervisor. Failure to use assigned campsite or transfer of site without the permission of the CCAS's written approval WILL result in loss of camping privileges.
- The person renting the campsite must be an adult residing at the campsite and be responsible for the behavior and welfare of all other members staying at the campsite, including pets.
- Pets must be kept in camper or on a leash.
- When you arrive and before you set up, visit the Fair Board office to check in and receive your camping permit. Permit must be visible from the road so that in an emergency, you can be easily found.
- NO outside refrigerators unless part of your camper.
- Open fires will be permitted in 24" contained ring only. Camper must furnish ring. All fires must be contained within your fire ring. Do not use skids, pallets, etc., that are too big to fit. Also, don't burn anything containing metal such as nails, staples, screws, bolts, hinges, etc.
- Intoxicating beverages (except at your campsite), profane or vulgar language, excessive noise, or disorderly conduct of any type will not be tolerated. Any of these is sufficient reason for the eviction from camping areas and fairgrounds, without refund of unused fees.
- Camping areas must be quieted by 12pm midnight CURFEW TIME and campers must be on their respective lots by then. Any person not observing the curfew time may be evicted.
- There will be no generator use after 12pm midnight.
- No one is permitted to sleep in a car.
- No camper water is to be dumped on the ground. All gray and black water must be disposed of at dump sites. Solid waste, garbage, cans, and paper is to be disposed of in trash barrels. Absolutely NO leaking of gray or black water. Violators may be asked to leave and their camping fees forfeited. No grilling, cooking, fire rings, or other sources of open flames is permitted under awnings or canopies.
- Bicycles are allowed on the campgrounds and fairgrounds. Golf carts or gators are also allowed with no fee. Use common sense safety precautions and no one except licensed drivers may operate them. NO ATV / Four-Wheelers are allowed. 10mph Speed Limit.
